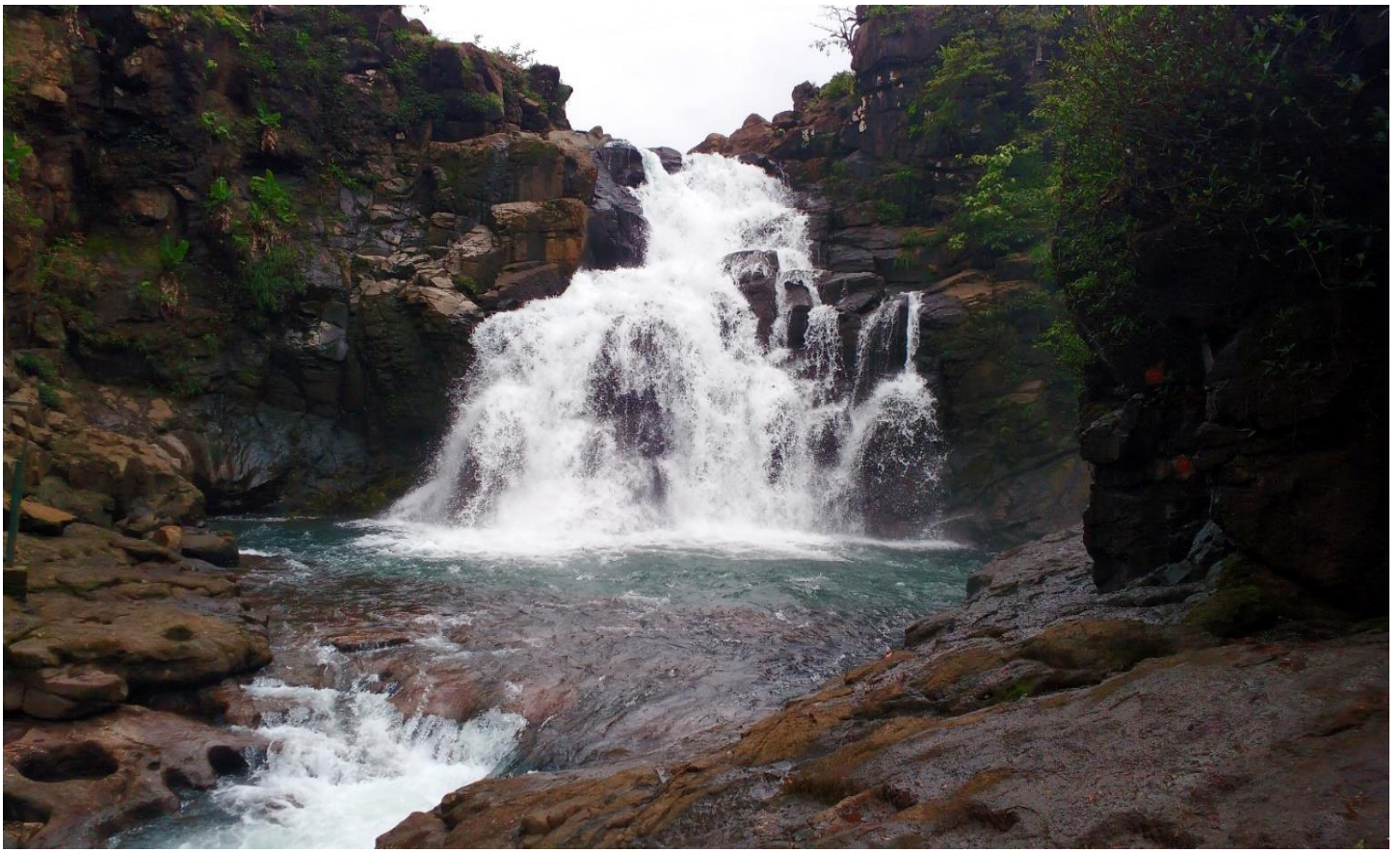

## Background of Trust

Shashwat Trust, Manchar has been founded in year 1996. However, Kusum Karnik started noble social work through this trust in year 1981 while conducting a rehabilitation exercise for the affected tribal citizens displaced due to construction of Dimbhe Dam in Ambegaon Taluka. The main focus of work was on the needs of these people, like construction of bunds on sloppy lands, called '*Padkai*', registration of lands, land bifurcation, installation of borewell, digging of wells and lakes for provision of water, health awareness programs across *Balwadi* (Kindergartens) and schools to fight malnutrition, conducting camps and seminars to generate awareness among women, Dairy Farming, Sludge Farming Program to yield food required for own family, Fishery, Katkari crisis, Katkari Gharkul, Smokeless Stove, Poultry, Tree Plantation, Nursery, Forests crisis, sanctuaries, etc. All these programs have been conducted in Ambegaon, Khed and Junnar Blocks.

# Activities: Year 2020-21



## 1) Education and Awareness

Education is need of the moment and access to education is a fundamental right of every human being. That's why, Shashwat Trust is committed to ensure that education reaches to every individual, from children to adults, through various initiatives like Balwadi, Abhyasvarg, Adult Literacy Program, etc. and persistent efforts are being made to bring them into mainstream. Apart from core education, men and women are sensitized about health and academics related information. Further, various meets, seminars and camps are organized to spread awareness about health as well as education.



## 2) Balwadi

Balwadis is the heart of Shashwat Trust because it was the initial stepping stone of Shashwat's vast amount of social work it has done over the years. It was not possible to run Balwadis due to lockdown restrictions amidst COVID-19 pandemic. So, Balwadi teachers prepared Rajgira Laddoos and nutritious Laddoos themselves, and distributed among children. As these teachers are local residents; they reached out to children through home visits and sensitized them about hygiene, clipping nails and cutting hair at regular interval, etc.

### 3) Tuition Classes

Looking at the COVID-19 pandemic crisis, the Shashwat Trust made a decision to establish and run Abhyasvarg in various villages. These Abhyasvarg were planned for a period of 6 months, from October 2020 to March 2021. A total of 868 students attended Abhyasvarg. Abhyasvarg covers students from first to sixth standard. However, students studying in seventh to tenth standard also joined Abhyasvarg. So, the overall strength of students increased.

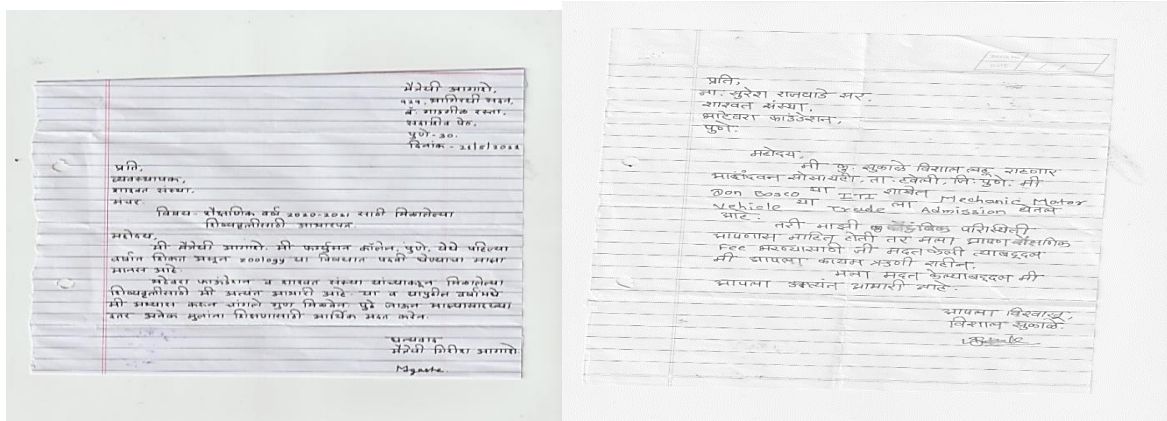

## 4) Educational Assistance

Since many years, needy and promising students are being awarded scholarship in the form of fee on behalf of Shashwat Trust. Since last 3 years, scholarships are being awarded to students by Bhatewara Foundation. One old (existing scholarship-holder) student has received scholarship while 5 new students have received it this year. Further, 4 old (existing scholarship-holder) and 9 new students of Don Bosco Private Industrial Training Institute have received scholarship for training. Thus, a total of 19 students have been benefitted with scholarship.

## 5) Initiatives Undertaken for Women Empowerment in Block – Khed

Some key women empowerment initiatives like Adult Education Course, Domestic Violence Guidance Program for Women and celebration of International Women's Day, etc. are underway in Khed Block. Adult Education Course has been established so that women in tribal village are enabled to read and write, become capable of conducting financial transactions themselves and learn to place their own signature. These women have started writing their own names and place their own signature now. Domestic Violence Guidance Program for Women was conducted at Dhuvoli village in Khed Block with an objective of checking domestic violence and propagating knowledge of legal provisions till each woman. The women in tribal areas are always busy with some or the other task. International Women's Day program was organized by the Shashwat Trust for the women in Khed Block so that they can spend a day's time at leisure and spare some time for self.

## 6)Tree Cultivation

The forest cutting crisis is making earth's situation critical. The earth's atmosphere is getting alarmingly imbalanced, Oxygen level has gone down drastically and temperature on Earth is increasing, too. Upon thoughtful consideration of all of the above mentioned factors, our trust is implementing Tree Cultivation project for the purpose of protecting the environment. In Year 2020-21, as per demand placed by the local farmers; saplings of fruit trees like mango, cashew, jackfruit, guava, sugar apple (Sitaphal), Amla, etc. were distributed and cultivated. Further, Jungle Saplings were cultivated at Jambhalewadi. All the Jungle Saplings that were planted last year were conserved properly. Tree plantation will boost growth of forests and assist maintaining balance of environment.

## 7) Mango Tree Cultivation

A total of 2620 grafted mango saplings were distributed to 274 farmers in tribal villages on behalf of Shashwat Trust. 2620 protective mesh were also distributed to protect saplings. Every farmer was handed over around 5 to 10 saplings. Farmers cultivated these sapplings in their own fields. The beneficiaries participated in this initiative and contributed in activities like digging pits, to refill them, to cultivate saplings, to water saplings, to remove grass/ weed, etc. This project will

help in tree cultivation and boost growth of forests as well as reduce the deterioration of environment to a certain extent.

## 8) Grocery Distribution

Entire world has been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic crisis. Lockdown has been imposed throughout the country. Though this decision has been made in the best interest of the public, it is showing ill effects at a larger scale now. A large section of population in Maharashtra relies on work allotted on daily wages. Such type of employment completely halted during lockdown. It resulted into the starvation crisis. Grocery and life essential items were distributed to needy families belonging to labor, Katkari, Thakar, Mahadev Koli, Fase Pardhi, domestic helpers, women collecting garbage/scrap, etc. communities residing in Khed and Ambegaon Blocks.

## 9) Health

The tribal areas in Ambegaon Block used to witness severe level of malnutrition 30 years ago. Further, the mortality rate in children was also quite high. People did not have enough food and grains for their survival. Shashwat Trust studied this case and started working on the health crisis. The Health Project is being implemented in 20 villages. Initiatives like spreading awareness among women, taking care of health, organizing training sessions and meets, bringing women to hospital promptly, to provide them with medical treatment, undertaking various surgeries for women by organizing different types of camps, and implementing Backyard Garden, Tablets Distribution, Village Cleaning Mission, spreading awareness about COVID-19 Pandemic and completion of vaccination, recording weight and height and distributing calcium tablets on the occasion of the International Women's Day, providing guidance to adolescent girls and distribution of nutritional Laddoos, etc. were organized as a part of health project successfully.

## 10) Diwali Snacks Distribution

Diwali snacks items are being distributed to many underprivileged families in Ambegaon Block on behalf of Shashwat Trust, Manchar. In line with this tradition, Diwali snacks of Chiwda and Laddoos were distributed to a total of 450 families on Dt. 11/11/2020. Diwali snacks were distributed to Katkari families in Amde, Adiware, Vachape, Ambegaon, Fulawade, Dimbhe, Shinde Vasti, Mhalunge and Fase Pardhi families at Manchar. The said snacks were prepared at domestic level (not commercially) and then it was distributed.



## 11) Nursery Project

The basic purpose of Nursery Project was to provide the opportunity of employment to residents of western tribal area of Ambegaon Block through setting up of an herbal nursery. The trust had an idea of providing the residents with a supporting business through cultivation of herbal saplings in these nurseries. As entailed to this, 927 types of saplings were collected from forests and nursery was cultivated. A total of 22626 saplings were produced from this nursery. The women have got an employment opportunity at local level.





## 12) Sludge Farming

The tribal people that are displaced due to Dimbhe Dam undertake Sludge Farming once the water in the dam recedes beyond a certain level. During this initiative, a land area admeasuring around 700 – 800 hectares from 19 villages was available for farming for a period of 6 to 7 months. Sludge Farming is being implemented in Dimbhe Lake as a part of this initiative on behalf of Shashwat Trust since Year 2006. Dimbhe Lake has occupied around 2200 hectares of land. Around 150 farmers are cultivating crops in their own fields by Sludge Farming method in Year 2020-21 and generating adequate crop yield. The sludge farming project has been kicked off with an objective of preventing migration for the sake of employment and enablement of residents to earn their livelihood and yield food adequate to fulfill family's food requirement for 12 months. Sludge Farming has resulted into reduction in forest cutting activity. Further, the migration for the sake of employment has also been reduced to a certain extent.

## 13) Water Project

Shashwat Trust is working on the water crisis in the tribal area of Ambegaon Block. Many tanks have been dug on behalf of the trust in the past. However, with ever growing population and number of cattle, the amount of water in the tanks is decreasing in summer and it is getting contaminated, too. This eventually leads to a major health crisis. Upon thoughtful consideration of demands placed before the trust, a survey was conducted by Geologists and a Water Project was implemented.

## 14) Hirda Husk Sale

Hirda Machines have been distributed in tribal areas of Pimpri, Ahupe and Don on behalf of the Shashwat Trust. Women are collecting Hirda, making husk from it and selling it in nearby market place. Hirda husk worth Rs. 70,000 has been sold during Financial Year 2020-21. This has resulted into employment opportunities to many Self Help Groups (Bachat Gats).

# आदिवासींना पिण्यासाठी स्वच्छ पाणी

## आंबेगाव तालुक्याच्या पश्चिम भागात सुविधा उपलब्ध; शाश्वत संस्थेचा उपक्रम

फुलवडे, ता. ६ : आंबेगाव तालुक्यातील पश्चिम आदिवासी भागात उन्हाळ्यात पाण्याची गंभीर समस्या निर्माण होते. त्यामुळे या भागातील मेनूबवाडी, कुंभेवाडी, डंबवाडी, पोटेवाडी, जांभळेवाडी, आहूणे, बालवोववाडी, पिराणे, आषाणे आणि पिरा या ठिकाणी तळ्यांचे खोदकाम करून त्यावर जलशुद्धीकरण प्रकल्प बसविण्यात आल्याची माहिती शाश्वत संस्थेचे उपाध्यक्ष सुरेश राजवाडे यांनी दिली. यामुळे आदिवासी नागरिकांना पिण्यासाठी स्वच्छ पाणी उपलब्ध झाले आहे.

शाश्वत संस्था आदिवासी भागात गेल्या २४ वर्षांपासून विविध प्रकल्प करत आहे. या भागात उन्हाळ्यात पाण्याची भीषण समस्या असते. गावातील महिलांना दोन ते तीन

किलोमीटर पायी जाऊन डोक्यावर हंडा घेऊन पाणी आणावे लागते. यामुळे महिलांच्या आरोग्याचा प्रश्न निर्माण होतो. शाश्वत संस्थेमार्फत पूर्वी तळ्यांची खोदकामे करून केली होती. परंतु, वाढती लोकसंख्या व पाळोव जनावरांमुळे या भागात पाण्याची समस्या निर्माण होते. दूषित पाण्यामुळे या भागातील ग्रामस्थांना अनेक आजारना सामोरे जावे लागते. यामुळे ग्रामस्थांनी तळ्यांचे खोदकाम व बांधकाम करून त्यावर जलशुद्धीकरण प्रकल्प बसवून मिळावेत, अशी मागणी या संस्थेकडे केली होती.

त्यानुसार संस्थेच्या कार्यकर्त्यांनी गावांचा सर्व्हे केला. तसेच भूगर्भ शस्त्रशमार्फत तळ्यांचा देखील सर्व्हे करण्यात आला. त्यानंतर तळ्यातील पाण्याची प्रयोगशाळेत तपासणी करण्यात आली. ज्या

ठिकाणी तळ्यातील पाणी अशुद्ध आहे, अशा ठिकाणी जलशुद्धीकरण प्रकल्प बसविण्यात यावेत, अशी मागणी ग्रामस्थांनी केली. त्यानुसार मेनूबवाडी, कुंभेवाडी, डंबवाडी, पोटेवाडी, जांभळेवाडी, आहूणे, बालवोववाडी, पिराणे, आषाणे,

पिरा या ठिकाणी जलशुद्धीकरण प्रकल्प बसविण्यात आले. या प्रकल्पासाठी आर्थिक सहाय्य मिसिडीव बेंझ, तर तांत्रिक सहाय्य होमसेवा संस्थेने केले.

या प्रकल्पाचे उद्घाटन करून हे प्रकल्प गावांकडे नुकतेच हस्तांतरित

### पाच रुपयांत २० लिटर पाणी...

या प्रकल्पामुळे पिरातील सर्वांना शुद्ध पाणी पिरण्यात मिळाला आहे. त्यामुळे या प्रकल्पाची सर्वांनी काळजी घ्यावी. एक रुपयात एक लिटर पाणी व पाच रुपयांत २० लिटर पाणी उपलब्ध होईल. ज्या होणाऱ्या पिरांचा विनियोग हा यंत्राची दुरुस्ती व देखभालसाठी करता येणार असल्याचे मिसिडीव बेंझ कंपनीच्या सोएसआर विभागाचे मंडार कुलकर्णी यांनी सांगितले.

६ या भागातील तळ्यांचे खोदकाम करण्यात आले असून, जलशुद्धीकरण प्रकल्प हे गावांकडे हस्तांतरित करण्यात आले आहेत. त्यांची देखभाल करणे हे ग्रामस्थांचे काम आहे. - अशोक आढाव, कोशाध्यक्ष, शाश्वत संस्था
